Subject: New Park Planned for Glengarry Avenue

HAVE YOUR SAY IN THE DESIGN WEDNESDAY MARCH 24 6:30 pm

With warmer weather in sight, BPRO residents are about to start spending more time in the City's parks. Happily, the City is working on creating several new parks across the City, including in North York.

A brand new 280 square metre park on Glengarry Avenue, west of Elm Road and directly adjacent to the Douglas Greenbelt, is in the planning stages and the City is looking for feedback from the community on its design.

As of now, the City says it's likely the park will include a children's playground, a shade structure and a seating area, but the final park concept is being developed in consultation with the community.

A virtual public meeting is scheduled for this coming Wednesday, March 24 at 6:30 pm. City staff will be presenting the design options that have been developed as a result of previous stakeholder and community feedback. To register for the virtual meeting, please click [HERE](#).

Participants will learn more about the project and will be given an opportunity to participate in a virtual question and answer session with the project team. Feedback gathered at this meeting will help inform a preferred design concept.

Following the meeting, an online survey will run from March 24 to April 11 to give residents an opportunity to provide feedback on the design options for this new park.

If all goes as planned, the design phase is scheduled to be completed this spring, and construction is set to begin in the spring of 2023 with a goal of completing the park by fall of that same year.
