## CANNABIS RETAIL APPLICATIONS

Dear Neighbour,

Cannabis retail applications are regulated by the province through the Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO), which falls under the Ministry of the Attorney General.

A cannabis retail application will not be considered if it is less than 150 metres from a school.

There are currently four applications for locations on Avenue Road, and one on Yonge Street, as follows:

**1961 Avenue Road** (AGCO File #997981)  
(currently Haute Classics north of Felbrigg)  
Applicant is *Leaf Lab Cannabis Dispensary*, listed as In Progress  
(public notice ends May 30, 2020)

**1887 Avenue Road**  
(formerly Starbucks on the NE corner of Roe)  
Applicant is *Weed Advisor*, not yet listed on the AGCO website

**1819 Avenue Road** (AGCO File #992229)  
(formerly Creative Interiors on the NE corner of Deloraine)  
Applicant is *Tokyo Smoke Company*, listed as In Progress  
(public notice ends June 3, 2020)

**1703 Avenue Road**  
(formerly the Second Cup on the SE corner Fairlawn)  
Applicant is *South of Temperance Cannabis Co.*, listed as In Progress  
(public notice is past, no decision yet by AGCO)

**3244 Yonge Street** (AGCO File # 946657)  
(south of Brookdale)  
Applicant is *Erbn Green*, list as In Progress

Councillor Colle is advocating for the province to put all cannabis retail applications on hold until the pandemic is over in order for the public to have the opportunity to register their views within the allotted window of time.
